The following is an agreement to be signed by the contestant and BOTH parents. Please read and understand the rules and all the duties that go with the title. This does not apply to Missouri Holstein Miss.

Character Statement:

I understand that if chosen for the Missouri Holstein Princess I am representing the Missouri Holstein Association at any event where dairy animals are exhibited or sold, even when not wearing the crown. I understand that I should carry myself in the manner in which the Missouri Holstein Association deems appropriate. These actions include, alcohol, tobacco, and illegal substance use. If caught mistreating the title, I will lose the title and the right to the Scholarship money. The Runner-Up will take over the duties and right to the Scholarship money. If there is no Runner-Up, the Missouri Miss will take over duties with no scholarship money. Conduct deemed to be improper and detrimental to the Missouri Holstein Association and Missouri Holstein Princess program will be reason for disqualification and dismissal. Disqualification will be determined by the Junior Advisor and the Holstein Board. A formal written complaint must be presented to the Executive Board and Junior Advisor within 30 days of incident to determine disqualification.

Contestant must be in good standing with the Missouri Junior Holstein Association.

If selected as Missouri Holstein Princess, you will attend and assist with the following:

- Missouri Holstein State Convention
- Missouri Holstein Field Day
- Missouri State Fair (Junior and Open shows)
- At least 3 District Shows

Proper attire is requested at these events; which includes dress and/or pant suit. (No jeans, Shorts, flip flops etc.)

The Missouri Holstein Princess will abide by all appearance obligations or will forfeit title and scholarship. Should there be a question as to if the Princess has fulfilled her duties the state junior advisor and at least 2 other district junior chairmen will decide.

Interview and crowning will take place during the State Holstein Convention in January. You will be informed of specific date and time once application is received. Appropriate attire is required for interview portion—Street Dress or Pant Suit (NO blue jeans)

Banquet attire (crowning)—Professional attire or Sunday dress

At the banquet you will be asked to give an introduction for yourself (no more than 30 seconds) giving your name, where you are from and tell about your involvement with Holsteins. Please be prepared with this in case you are selected. The winners will then be announced.

Prizes for Missouri Holstein Princess include the following: Crown, Sash, Flowers, and \$500 scholarship to college of your choice.
