Animal Health Requirements for Exhibitors

★ **Your Vet will need to contact the Oklahoma Veterinary Office concerning health requirements for cattle entering Oklahoma.**

Oklahoma State Veterinary Office 405-522-6141.

1. **Scabies (Mange):** Cattle originating in scabies quarantined areas or herds are not eligible to exhibit.
2. Any animal with a contagious disease (i.e. active ringworm) is not eligible for exhibition.

Exhibitors

Open Show Exhibitors: Must be an owner, or member of a partnership, owning the animal, in case a herd is registered or bred in the names of different members of a family, residing on one farm or breeding establishment, where the herd is one unit, all entries will be considered as a single exhibitor for all group classes.

Junior Exhibitors: Animals must be owned and shown by a junior member of the Holstein or Jersey Association. To be eligible to show each animal must be registered in the junior's name and the registration papers must be present at the show. Junior members eligible to show are those who have not reached his/her 21st birthday by January 1, 2025. All animals exhibited by juniors must be owned by that individual by show deadline. No Junior/Senior partnerships will be allowed in the Junior Show. Junior members need to pay only one entry fee to be eligible for the show. When you enter and pay in the Junior Show, you will automatically be entered in the Open Show.

Junior Bred & Owned: To be eligible for Junior Bred & Owned, at least one of the Junior owners must be listed as a breeder and owner on the registration certificate

Dress Code and Show Ring Harnesses: All exhibitors are required to wear white trousers or white skirts and Official Harnesses when leading animals in the ring.

Violation: Unacceptable Practice

Surgical or unethical insertion of any matter under the skin or into the body cavities, performed to change the natural contour or appearance of the animal's body (e.g., administration of fluid via a stomach tube or other similar apparatus to fill the rumen), after 12 a.m. on the day in which the animal is to show. Therapeutic administration of fluids by stomach pump will be allowed at other times, only if deemed to be needed by a Veterinarian in writing and presented to the Ethics Committee prior to the show. Failure to adhere to the rule will be cause for disqualification of the exhibition livestock and the exhibitor from the show.

Premier Breeder & Premier Exhibitor Rules

Premier Breeder: The owner of the dam at the time of service shall be considered the breeder of the animal. Where a herd is registered in the names of different members of a family, and where the herd is one unit, all entries may be considered as exhibits of one breeder. Otherwise, when

animals are bred in partnership, each unique partnership is considered a unique breeder.

Premier Exhibitor: The exhibitor must be the owner. In case a herd is registered or bred in the names of different members of a family, residing on one farm or breeding establishment, and where the herd is one unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for all group classes. However, members of one family, where cattle are not housed as one unit, will not be considered as a single exhibitor. When animals are owned in partnership, each unique partnership is considered a unique exhibitor.

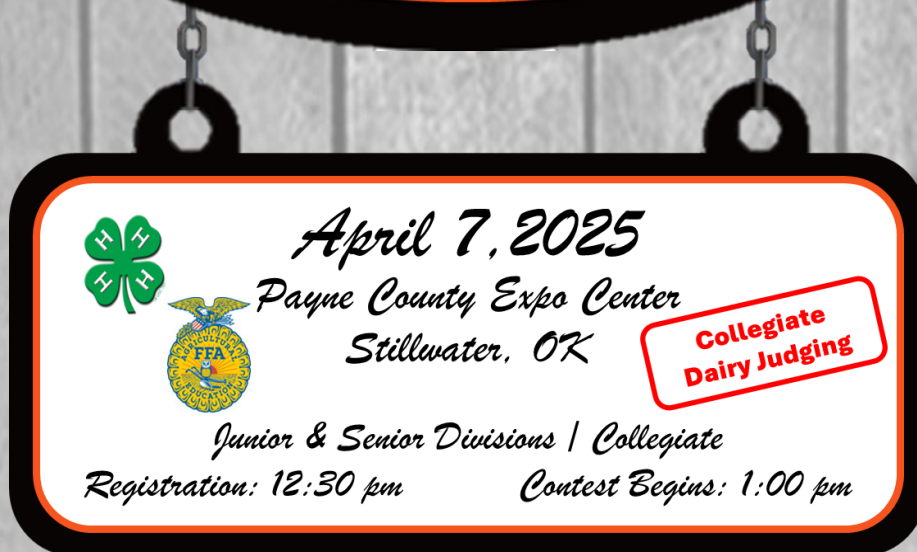
