REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Jr animals need to be in jr name by June 1. Application has to be in Brattleboro by June 1.

NATIONAL CONVENTION: This year's National Holstein Convention will be June 25- 28, 2014 in Dubuque, Iowa. Anyone interested in going please let Shannon know. 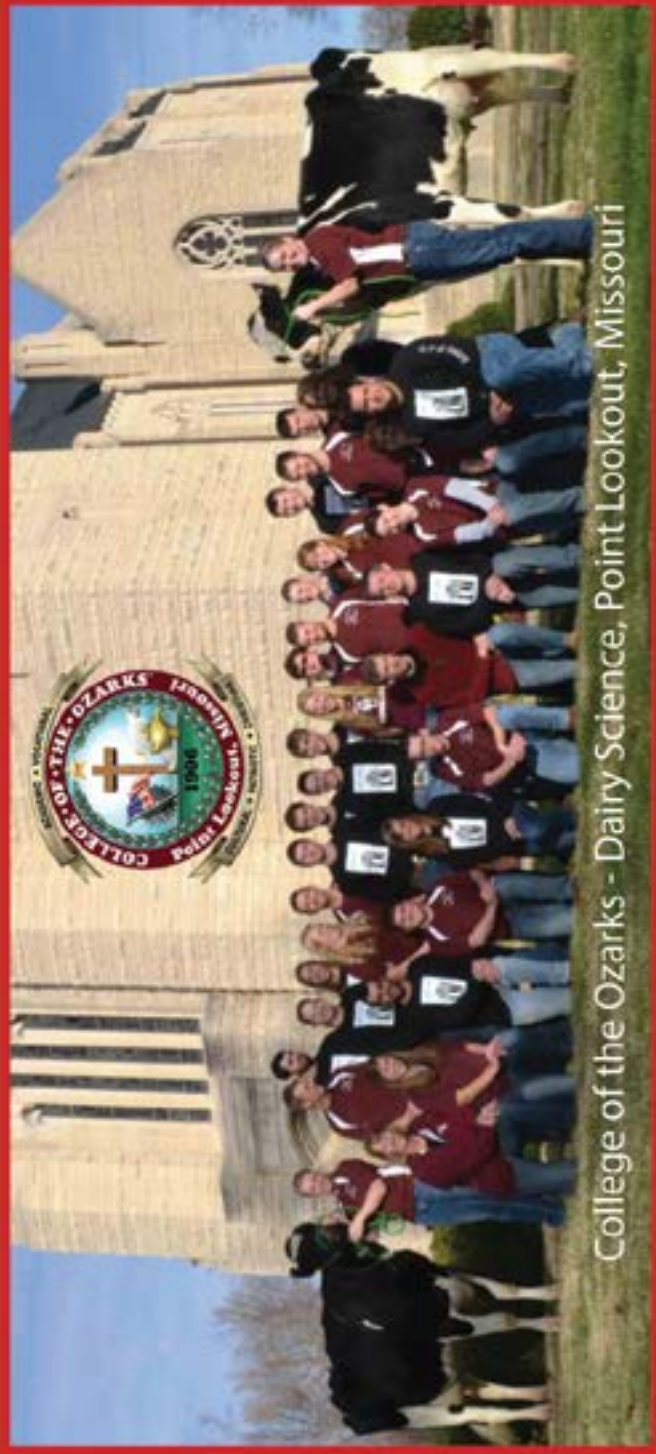

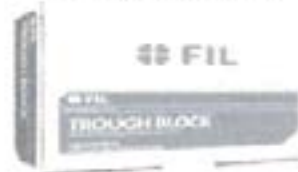
